

Healthy Start

Primary prevention program designed to reduce infant mortality and poor pregnancy outcomes. All pregnant women in Brevard County are eligible for this service at no cost. Services can start prenatal or after infant's birth. Infant mental health services are also available to support new parents and their infants who have been identified as needing assistance in addressing issues of abuse and neglect.

Clinical Services

In-home or in-school counseling for children between the ages of birth to 17 years, and their families. Services are available for clients who have Medicaid HMOs, including Medicaid (fee for service), United, Amerigroup, Staywell, Healthease, and Magellan Child Welfare Prepaid Mental Health Plan (CWPMHP). There are also funding options available for self-pay or Family Services Planning Team.

Residential Care

Hacienda Girls Ranch

Emergency shelter setting for teen girls who have been abused or neglected. Services include educational support, mental health counseling, independent living skills and opportunities for outside activities.

Transitional Living

Apartment style living for young ladies ages 18 – 23, who are in need of support as they transition to independence.

Behavioral & Mental Healthcare

Targeted Case Management

Support services to maintain children in the least restrictive environment possible. Case management and Multi-disciplinary Team (MDT) staffings are available for children w/ mental health diagnosis.

Family Services Planning Team

Case management and the coordination of staffings to arrange services that assist in maintaining emotionally disturbed children in their home

Dependency Case Management

All aspects of case management and individualized services are coordinated for children who may have been abused or neglected. Individualized support and an emphasis on family relationships are provided to preserve the family unit when appropriate. Staff works with various agencies and the court system to ensure the safety and support of children. CHS works with half of the Brevard County dependent children and Devereux serves the other half.
